








HARP origins: HORIZON 2020



The programme is **ATTRACTIVE** but **less than 1 in 3 high-quality proposals are funded:** additional **€116 bn** would have been needed to fund them all



200,000 proposals (twice as much per year compared to the predecessor programme FP7)

12% of them received funding

83% of projects declare they would not have gone ahead without EU funding


Participations by region (NUTS 3)

HARP origins: HORIZON 2020

- Research&Innovation Actions: create new know-how and technologies
- Innovation Actions: more specific and close-to-market actions, development and optimization of processes, technologies and solutions



- Coordination and Support Actions: research support measures (standardization, dissemination, creation of networks and partnerships, homogeneous EU policies, capacity building, strategic actions)
- EIC Accelerator (Ex SME Inst.): meant for highly innovative SMEs and start-ups (innovative products, services or business models)

7 June 2018


The Commission adopts its proposal for Horizon Europe

Horizon Europe is launched






HARP origins: H2020 project LabelpackA+

HARP objectives

- Support introduction of labelling systems for existing heating appliances (e.g. through a dedicated APP)
- Ensure such labelling mechanisms are adequately supported by (unbiased) information about existing alternatives
- Provide feedbacks on results and impact of such mechanisms to the EC
